

MANAGER'S REPORT by Mark Sloan

Our 2017 Annual Owner's Meeting was a success! Thanks to everyone for coming out on such a beautiful day. Congratulations to our newly elected Board members, Scott Baeten, Ken Paul and Tom Hurst. I have no doubt they will continue to do a fabulous job for us!

Allow me to share with you my regular Fall message; I understand that many of you read this every year, but as a reminder to everyone and hopefully to allow our newer Owners to be aware of our leaf removal strategy, that this time of year presents a long and difficult job for our Maintenance Department. We will be working as hard as we can to remove the leaves quickly and efficiently. However, I want to take a moment to remind everyone of a few key points with leaf removal. Someone will be the first to have their leaves removed and someone will be last in getting their leaves removed. It takes weeks to cover the entire resort. We will move as quickly as possible but please be patient with

us. Secondly, it is important to note that we will have to return back to areas 2-3 times before all of the leaves have fallen and they can be removed. So you may see us in an area and it will be cleaned up and looking nice, then a few days later, leaves are everywhere again and you will see us return. We do this because if we allow all of the leaves to fall before picking them up they become too wet or frozen to move and it's a mess that we can't keep up with. So, if it takes us a few weeks or better to cover the resort and we have to do it 2-3 times then you can see that total leaf removal is a several month job! We also have plans to start on the leaves as early as possible and stay on them. By getting on it and staying on it earlier, we hope to be ahead of the curve if we have a bad winter again.

We are currently working on the 2018 budgets! Management, the Board and Finance Committee are all working as hard as we can to put in place the absolute best budget we can for 2018. As always, we will be doing all we can to provide the most reasonable and ef-

ficient budget possible for our Association. The Board will be approving the 2018 Budgets at the November meeting (November 18th). You will then be receiving your copies of those budgets for your review and ultimate approval in January. More information will be forthcoming later in the year.

I want to thank each of you for your generous donations to this year's Employee Appreciation Day and for the volunteers that helped with the food and clean up. From all of us, to all of you, THANKS! For making all of us feel appreciated!
